Introduction


The MFJ-1790 is a simple lightweight off center fed vertical antenna. It's simple construction and lightness allow for easy installation almost anywhere. The single band design is engineered for maximum efficiency and low radiation angle resulting in strong DX signals.

What's in the box

Base assembly with main radiator.
Two radial tubes with slotted ends
Main radiator extension.
Parts pack with end caps hose clamps and U-bolt.

How to assemble the antenna

The antenna may be assembled on the ground or using supports such as saw horses. Since there are only two radials, the antenna will lie flat on the ground if desired. Slide one hose clamp onto the end of each radial that has a slot, do not tighten the clamp. Slip each radial over the 5/16 rod extending from the base all the way to the bolt. Tighten the clamp making sure that no part of the clamp touches the base bolt below it. Install the 7/16 radiator using the supplied 4-40 screw to attach the tube to the base. Slide the tube over the rod extending from the base insulator and align the hole with the one in the tube. Insert the 4-40 screw and tighten.



Install the top section of the radiator using the 3/8 tube that does not have the slot. Slide the tube inward until the total length of the vertical element is 11 feet. This is a general length and should get the antenna close to 28.350MHz. Final tuning should be done with an antenna analyzer or swr meter. Radiator length may vary slightly depending upon your mounting location. Push the tube caps over the ends of the elements and test the antenna before mounting in it's final location. Mount the antenna at least 3 feet from the ground in a vertical position for testing. It will be much easier to tune the antenna on the ground than to attempt tuning at a higher position.

Mounting the antenna

Mount the antenna using the supplied u-bolt to your mast or you may secure the bracket directly to any non-metalic structure. The antenna must be at least 3 feet off the ground. Do not allow the elements to contact the mounting structure or any tree branches as this may cause arcing. Additional holes in the bracket will allow for mounting to a horizontal mast by turning the u-bolt sideways.

- **3.** MFJ Enterprises, Inc. will supply replacement parts free of charge for any MFJ product under warranty upon request. A dated proof of purchase and a **\$5.00** personal check, cashiers check, or money order must be provided to cover postage and handling.
